



## Qlik<sup>®</sup> Sense 2.0.6 – Release notes

Qlik Sense 2.0.6 is the latest release on the Qlik Sense 2.0 Service Release track. The Service Release track only includes bug fixes. Details of the fixes included in 2.0.6 are shown below. Please read the release notes thoroughly before installing or upgrading Qlik Sense.

NOTE: If you are running Qlik Sense 2.1.1 you cannot install version 2.0.6.

### Bug fixes

---

#### **SAML: SHA-256 signing algorithm does not work**

Jira issue ID: QLIK-45623

The SHA-256 algorithm was not functioning for SAML authorization.

#### **Binary sync fails while batch importing 40+ apps**

Jira issue ID: QLIK-44516

While importing a large number of apps apps would in some cases be corrupted and cause the sync to fail.

#### **XLSX Export does not accurately name the 27th row**

Jira issue ID: QLIK-38143

When exporting data to an Excel XLSX file, the 27<sup>th</sup> row would get an inaccurate name label.

#### **Group policy "allow log on locally" prevents users to log into Hub/QMC**

Jira issue ID: QLIK-40128

If form authentication was used and the group policy "allow log on locally" had no local users or domain users set, users would be prevented from logging in.

### Known issues and limitations

---

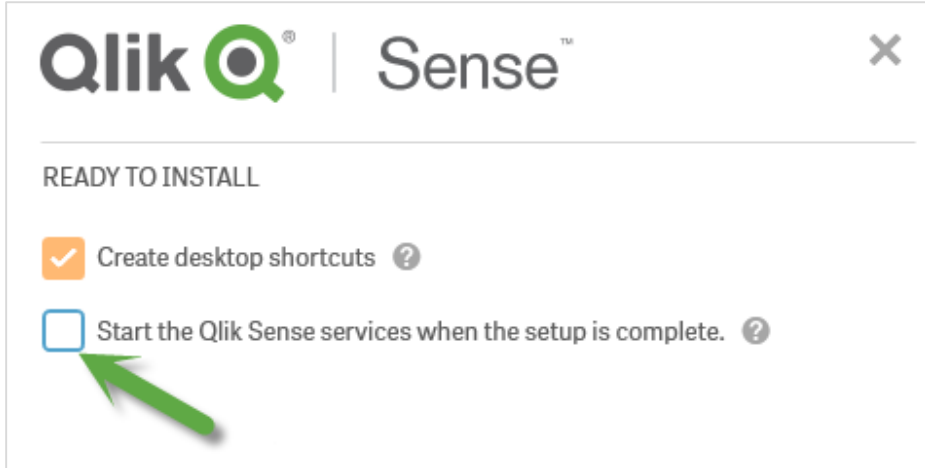
The following issues and limitations were identified at release time. The list is not comprehensive; it does however list all known major issues and limitations. The ambition is to have the issues fixed in later versions of Sense.

#### **Migration service cannot establish web socket to Engine**

In some cases, App Migration may not work because the Migration service cannot establish a websocket connection to the Qlik Engine.

**Workaround:**

1. Depending on the scenario:
  - If you are installing Qlik Sense: Uncheck the “Start the Qlik Sense services when the setup is complete” checkbox during the installation.



- If installation already has been performed: Stop all Qlik Sense services.
2. Start all services except the Dispatcher service.
  3. Make sure you can access the Hub and the apps to verify that the Engine is running.
  4. Start the Dispatcher service.
  5. Access QMC and import/migrate apps again.
